Rocker cover gasket selection
ref. 11122200 & 11122300 in VAG
Group engines



SCOPE


Indicate the **main differences** between part numbers **11122200** and **11122300** to help our customers to **choose the correct gasket** according to the rocker cover of the engine.

DESCRIPTION

From the year 2009 onwards, the 1.6 and 2.0 TDI engines of VAG group use **two different types of rocker cover** and each of them assemble a gasket that shows some differences to the other one. Those differences make both gaskets non-interchangeable.

Those rocker cover gaskets are 11122200 and 11122300 part numbers. **Depending on the rocker cover of the vehicle** we will use a gasket or another. For it, we will observe the shape and appearance of the rocker cover before taking a final decision.

On the other hand, we also can identify the original gasket and the original rocker cover **according to its part number**, indicated in the next table:

Now, the differences between both gaskets and rocker covers are shown.

The main difference is on the edge of the rocker cover. We can see that, in the case of the 11122200 gasket, the edge of the rocker cover is straight (as well as the gasket) while, in the case of 11122300 gasket, the edge has an entries.

In conclusion, the edge of the rocker cover will have the same form of the gasket.
