Optimized tensioner and deflection pulley bearings

New sealing concept

Due to the continuous development of our products, the bearings of many tensioner and deflection pulleys are now equipped with a new sealing concept. This innovative sealing system has the advantage of significantly higher resistance to harmful external influences including dust, dirt and moisture.

A decisive difference to the previous tensioner and deflection pulleys is that the cover cap (Figure 1) is no longer required. Due to the optimization, it is no longer included as a package insert in the new versions (Figure 2).

In the transition phase, mixed stock in the warehouse may result in tensioner and deflection pulleys being supplied with a cover cap as well as without a cover cap. Both versions meet the technical specifications and can be installed without any problems.

Important:

It is not possible and not necessary to convert cover caps that have already been used in tensioner and deflection pulleys using the new sealing concept!
